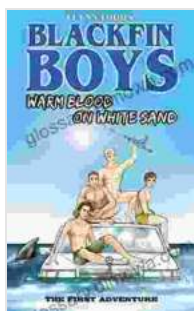


Blackfin Boys: Warm Blood on White Sand

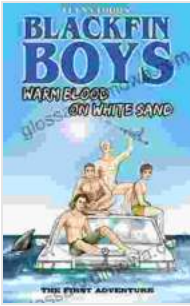
