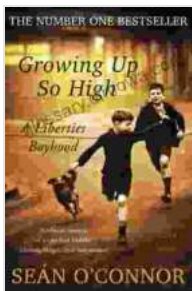


# Growing Up So High: A Boyhood Spent Soaring Above the World

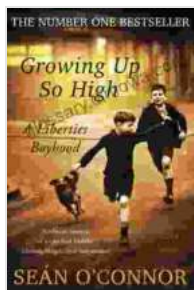
